Course Description

This three-day school will consist of 50% in-classroom training and 50% hands-on assembly training on the production floor of a Vanguard Jaw Crusher and a Pioneer Horizontal Shaft Impactor. Training will cover basic lubrication, wear component replacement, shaft and bearing assembly and adjustment of both jaws and horizontal impactors. Troubleshooting and application of both pieces of equipment that could affect the efficiency and longevity will also be covered. Attendees must be present at the end of the final day of the school to receive their training certificate.
